

PUBLIC RECORDS REQUEST

The California Public Records Act (Government Code § 6250 et seq.) was enacted to ensure public access to public records. Central Contra Costa Sanitary District has established administrative procedures in accordance with the California Public Records Act whereby persons may inspect District records during business hours at the Headquarters Office Building and/or may obtain copies upon payment of a fee. The charge for copies is \$0.15 per page.

This form, though not required by law, will enable the District to accurately and efficiently produce existing documents responsive to your request and that are not exempted from disclosure by law. Within 10 days of receipt of this request, the District will notify you by e-mail or phone number provided on this form when the responsive records will be available for inspection and if applicable the fee for duplication.
