#### **ISSUE**

The Board of Directors (Board) approval is required for the California State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) mandated update of the Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP).

#### **BACKGROUND**

The SWRCB first introduced a waste discharge requirement (WDR) permit (SWRCB Order No. 2006-0003) on May 2, 2006, to regulate sanitary sewer systems. Central San has continuously maintained compliance with this order and its subsequent revisions. This SSMP update continues that compliance continuity and adheres to the latest regulatory required Statewide General WDR for Sanitary Sewer Systems: Water Quality Order No. 2022-0103 DWQ, adopted by the SWRCB on December 6, 2022, and effective date of June 5, 2023.

The WDR stipulates that all collection systems over 500 miles must update their SSMP by June 2025. In addition, the new WDR requires the SSMP to be updated every six years. Therefore, the next update will be in June 2031.
